If you have a written management plan and provide us with information on how you have worked with the Colorado State Forest Service to mitigate the risk of catastrophic wildfire on your forestland, the American Forest Foundation's *Shared Streams* program will send you a 12" x 18" aluminum sign that you can post on your property. Eligible forest owners must hold more than 10 acres and submit an application approved by their Colorado State Forest Service Forester, detailing the management practices they have employed to reduce the risk of catastrophic wildfire on their property.
